




Alan Bates, DO – A Heart of Service

Application Eligibility/Criteria

- All fourth-year COMP-Northwest students who match into a Family Practice Residency with Osteopathic Recognition will be eligible for the \$20,000 Alan C. Bates Scholarship.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need through the filing of FAFSA. DACA students must submit a 2015 Federal Tax Return.
- The selection committee reserves the right to request additional materials, references, letters of support, and information necessary to evaluate the student's application.

Application Requirements

- The application period is March 17, 2017 through April 21, 2017.
(all required materials to be submitted by 5:00pm Pacific Time on April 21, 2017)
- Completed Alan C. Bates Scholarship Application
- Letter of good standing from the WesternU Registrar's Office
- Current curriculum vitae or resume; including community and/or professional involvement
- An essay, up to a 500 words, focusing on a strong commitment to Osteopathic medicine, practicing the full scope of Family Practice, and displaying a "Heart of Service".
